The purpose of this letter is to justify the employment of Mr. Robert Gerrick, Ms. Jill Isaacson, and Ms. Terry Kalten in the Graduate Counseling Program. They are functioning as supervisors of practicum students in MHS 6800, Practicum in counseling under the supervisions of Dr. Masson. Dr. Masson is teaching the didactic portion of that course and supervising practicum students and Jill Issacson, Terry Kalten, and Rob Gerrick are supervising the practicum students' field experience. Dr. Masson is the faculty of record for the course.

As you know, the counseling program is accredited through CACREP. They limit the supervision of practicum students to a ratio of 5/1. With an enrollment of 31student, this requires 6 supervisors. CACREP permits master's level prepared counselors to supervise practicum students.
